Mr. Pig Massive Fire Reflector

The Mr. Pig Massive Fire Reflector consists of 5 panels. These panels are constructed with 3/4 X 1/8" angle iron steel and corrugated roofing tin. These panels are assembled without the need for additional tools. **CAUTION:** Assembly of the Mr. Pig Fire Reflector has the risk of finger pinch. The panels fit tightly together when assembled. A finger can easily be pinched. Always wear gloves when handling the panels of the Mr. Pig Massive Fire Reflector. Also, the legs on the back of each panel could possibly fold down unexpectedly and cause minor injury. See the Mr. Pig Massive Fire Reflector Instruction Sheet for Detailed Assembly Instructions. This is an outdoor, open air, style of cooking. There will be a spot of burned ground where the reflector is standing. **CAUTION:** The steel in contact with the fire will be extremely hot during the cooking process. If you are purchasing the Mr. Pig XL Air Roaster Kit for use at home, it is recommended to leave the Fire Reflector set up in a permanent location. Once you have cooked a pig, there will be a bed of coals left in the Fire Reflector. **CAUTION:** Some people might think that pouring water on the bed of coals is a good way to extinguish the bed of coals. While this will indeed work, you will be left with a big muddy mess of black coals and water.

There are a couple of options to deal with a big bed of coals. 1. As recommended above, leave the Fire Reflector in a permanent location. Just leave the bed of coals to extinguish itself over a 3 – 5 days. Once

the coals have extinguished themselves, there will be a smaller pile of ashes that is easily removed. 2. Cover the bed of coals with dirt. This will allow the bed of coals to extinguish itself a day or so faster. Once the fire is extinguished, the dirt and ashes can be removed. A Flat Blade shovel is a good tool for ash pick up.

If you are cooking a pig at a remote location where you need to take the fire reflector with you after cooking, you will need to carefully move the panels away from the bed of coals. The fire reflector will lay out flat while it is still connected. Move the side panels out and lay the reflector on top of the bed of coals. Pull the reflector off the bed of coals, being careful not to spread to many coals out. The fire reflector can then be separated into its individual pieces, loaded up and hauled away. The bed of coals will still need to be covered with dirt to keep the coals protected from wind, rain, people, animals, etc. Anyone or anything that could possibly contact the bed of coals should be protected against any possibility of burn injury.

The Mr. Pig Ultimate A Frame is designed to help facilitate the cooking only. Any use other than cooking is not recommended. The A Frame if constructed with square, steel tubing. Every piece of tubing is designed to store and transport easily. **CAUTION:** The Legs and top bar are designed to slip inside of each other. This creates a finger pinch risk. Use Gloves when setting up or taking down the Ultimate A Frame. If you have purchased the Mr. Pig XL Air Roaster Kit for home use, it is ok to leave the Ultimate A Frame assembled. See the Mr. Pig XL Air Roaster Kit Assembly Instructions for details on assembly of the Mr. Pig Ultimate A Frame.
